Renovation of the orphanage



The orphanage building

After 14 years of service many things in the orphanage building have begun to break and deteriorate with time. Some of these include the roof, window screens, floor tiles and shower heads. The roof is the item that seems to be in worst shape since when it rains the water leaks into the orphanage. We

plan to change the whole roof to a metal sheet roof with insulation underneath to help heat dissipation. In addition we also plan to add an extra layer of security to the orphanage building by installing vertical metal sheet doors to the entrance of the building on the first floor, this is because due to the way we designed the orphanage in the beginning we wanted to leave the 1st floor open to maximize as much airflow as possible but now after some years we feel that at night the 1st floor is too open and not very safe for the children. So we feel that installing vertical closing metal sheet doors will help retain the airflow during the day since it will be opened and it will be more secure at night since it can be closed.

We plan to begin our renovation in January 2019 and we hope to finish before the monsoon season which is in the middle of May. The budget for renovation that we have set is \$17,188 in total. The break up of costs is as follows:

Labor cost: \$5,313

Cost of materials: \$11,875
