

At the orphanage this year we have a total of 25 children. The children's schools reopened about a month ago and the children are all going to school now. There was however, an incident of covid on the children's first week of school as 7 of our children got covid. We thank God that their symptoms were mild and they all made a full recovery in about a week. Please continue to keep all the children of Suk Jai Children's home in your prayers.

At this moment it is now nearing the time for planting rice and we must get the fields ready for rice planting at the orphanage. An important tool we use to get the fields ready for rice planting is the grass cutter machine. The 2 grass cutter machines that we have at the orphanage are both very old and broken to the point where the repair shop says that they can no longer be fixed since we have been using both of them for over 10 years. This is why we would like to purchase 2 new grass cutter machines for the orphanage to replace the old ones since they are now broken. The cost for one grass cutter machine is \$445. We also have to overhaul the orphanage's tractor which we also use to prepare the rice field for rice planting, this overhaul will cost around \$441. Please pray with us that we will have the necessary funds to purchase these grass cutter machines and funds to overhaul the orphanage's tractor.
