Due to this both have been expelled from school and will also need to leave the orphanage as well. On the brighter side this year we will have 5 new children joining us at the orphanage, 3 boys and 2 girls. The total number of children that we have now is 26. Thank God in the past few years the orphanage has provided music lessons to older children. Many older children can now play music. Every Sunday during worship time at church, the children have formed a worship band and lead worship at church.
